Kitchen

- Stove (Double burner for more than 2 people)
 - □ Fule (propane/butane as per stove requirements)
 - □ Lighter/match sticks
- Cookware
 - □ Kettle for boiling water
 - Deep pan
 - □ Frying pan
 - Spatula
 - Tong

- □ Knife and chopping board
- Utensils
 - □ Spoons, forks, or sporks
- Cups for water and tea/coffee
- Plates and bowls
- $\hfill\square$ Condiments, spices, and cooking oil
 - □ Salt and pepper
 - □ Ketchup, mustard, or hot sauce
 - Spices and herbs
 - Cooking coil
- Cleaning
 - □ Kitchen towels
 - Rag cloths
 - Trash bags
 - Dishwashing soap and scrub

Water and food

- One gallon of water per person per day
- □ Grocery for each meal of the day
- □ Snacks and protein bars

Fire, lights, and tools

- Lighter/stormproof match sticks/ferrous rod
- □ Firestarter
- Camping knife
- Saw/hatchet
- □ Shovel
- □ Headlamp/flashlight
- Camping lantern

Electronics

- Mobile phone
- □ Chargers/power bank
- U Walkie talkie/GMRS/Ham radio (optional)

Medical kit

- Prescription medication, if any
- OTC pain and fever reducer

□ Anti-allergy

- Anti-nausea and stomach upset
- Bandaid and wound cleaning kit
- □ Tripple antibiotic ointment
- □ Medication for children

Insects and animals

- Insect repellent spray or ointment
- □ Mosquito coil/citronella candle
- Bear spray (for bear country, check regulations)

- Book
- Musical instrument
- Board/card games
- Bike/scooters
- Frisbee/ball
- □ Binoculars
- □ Scavenger hunt list
